# Actor's Terms and Conditions

## CASTINGS

Murder Most Foul will contact actors by email to inform them of forthcoming Murder Mystery Events. The actors must reply indicating the dates that they are available for. Failure to do this means actors may not be cast. If actors indicate availability, please honour that commitment. We understand that personal circumstances change, but if actors regularly turn down castings, we are likely to stop offering events. If an actor is offered a casting and finds that he/she cannot participate after all please notify us IMMEDIATELY.

If cast at an event please ring the Event Organiser at least 4 days before the event to confirm attendance.

## EVENTS

Actors are required to be at an event 90 minutes before the start. As most events commence at 7.30pm, actors should arrive by 6pm. Should actors experience a problem, then please contact the Event Organiser without delay.

## CLIENTS

Should there be an issue with the client, an employee of the client, the client's facilities or another actor, inform the Event Organiser without delay. The Event Organiser is the ONLY person authorised to deal with issues.

## EXPENSES

Any remuneration paid to an actor is to cover expenses and it is the actor's responsibility to declare this payment for tax reasons.

Actors accepting a lift to an event from another actor/organiser, should offer to help cover the driver's expenses.

## ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation obtained by an actor is at the actor's own expense.

## COSTUMES

For normal events it is the actor's responsibility to dress in a costume appropriate to the part they are playing. However, if it is a specialist event then Murder Most Foul will hire appropriate costumes. On occasion it may be appropriate for an actor to hire their costume locally and the cost be reimbursed by Murder Most Foul. In such a case, the actor MUST seek the permission of Murder Most Foul BEFORE hiring a costume or reimbursement may not be made.

## PROFESSIONALISM

An actor will behave in a professional manner at all times when at a client's premises. Any actor found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or who behaves in a manner detrimental to Murder Most Foul during an event, will be asked to leave the client's establishment immediately, and will not be cast for any future event. At some events there may be free drink, or the guests may offer to buy the actor drinks, this is not to be accepted. The Event Organiser may allow this if in his/her opinion to refuse the hospitality may appear to be rude.

Actors must remain in character at all times until the event is completed.

In the interests of health and safety, any interaction or performance that requires choreography (such as a fight scene) must in all circumstances be rehearsed beforehand. The choreography must then be strictly adhered to during the performance. If it has not been rehearsed it must not be performed.

## MISCELLANEOUS

Information provided by Murder Most Foul is confidential and no actor may share any such information with any client or competitor.

The signing of the Actors' Application Form by the actor confirms that the actor has read, understood and agrees with these Terms and Conditions and, once signed the Terms and Conditions are binding upon the actor.

Murder Most Foul reserves the right to change these Terms and Conditions without notice and consultation. Any changes will be notified to all actors.
